

WHAT IS THE MONTESSORI CHILDREN'S HOUSE PHILOSOPHY?

Our method of education is a philosophy and curriculum developed by Dr. Maria Montessori. The method rests upon respect for the child, recognition of the potential for full development within each child and a commitment to fostering each child's capabilities according to his or her rate of development. The child's natural motivation to learn is encouraged while emphasis is placed on the development of concentration, independence and self-confidence. We focus on instilling in the children, in all the ethnic backgrounds they contribute, values, morals and a sense of pride. The classroom is designed to encourage exploration and to provide an atmosphere where a child can succeed, and learning is fun. In this way we hope to help the child in learning about him or herself and to instill a love of learning to carry with throughout their life! This is the Children's House!

We are located at 5114 Jefferson Ave. (Just North of Wheeler Rd.).

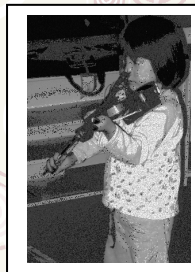
HOW MANY CHILDREN ARE IN EACH CLASSROOM?

We are licensed for 30 children per session. Classrooms with 24-30 students enrolled have three or more teachers, including at least one Montessori certified head teacher and certified Montessori assistants!



WHAT IS THE CLASSROOM LIKE?

The classrooms have been modernized, and give your children the best educational experience possible. We have created an "at home" environment, with certified teachers that provide safe & clean surroundings for the children. The children are allowed to move freely. The Montessori prepared environment has an Everyday Living, Sensorial, Math, Language, Art, Science, Library, Geography and Cultural Studies, Computer and Cooking area. The curriculum provides immersion in Spanish, Yoga, Music, and weekly crafts. We integrate American Sign into Group Time and have recently added a library to the lower level of the school to enhance our language curriculum. A Suzuki violin and Early Childhood Music program is available to students and their families as an after school program option.



We have two beautiful play-yards, where outdoor playground time is part of each day.

WHAT IS MCH SUMMER CAMP?

We believe children work hard enough the rest of the year, so when summer comes, they deserve some extra fun! That's why Montessori Children's House turns into MCH Summer Camp. We are a professionally run day camp with fun activities inside a beautiful environment with air conditioning or outside on 2 ½ acres of land with two playgrounds. MCH Summer Camp is designed for two age groups: Preschool (3-5 years) and School Aged children (6-10 years).
